Assessments evaluate performance in one venue to predict performance in another venue.



Approximations to save time, effort, money, and collateral damage.



Performance: always best, but most expensive



Hardware vs Software

Hardware

Traits or tendencies tend to be with an individual for the most of their adult lives

We all have certain attributes that are hard-wired into us

Examples

Software

Software is all about how we were scripted or sculpted by others, especially in family/culture of origin

We developed software to deal with conflict, emotions, and relationships

Each has a dramatic influence on how we perform later in life

Change is possible through intentional efforts, coaching, and accountability

Firmware

Interaction of Software and Hardware

Rock includes five assessment instruments:

- DISC (Hardware)
- Motivators (Firmware)
- Emotional Intelligence (Software)
- Conflict Profile (Software)
- Spiritual Gifts (Firmware)

4 Matters to Manage: Hardware

+Traits or tendencies that are unlikely to change outside of some significant emotional event

+ Issues to Resolve: Software

+Behaviors that can be modified over time with effective coaching or counseling are considered soft-wired

Assessments identify issues, they don't resolve them

Assessors are not infallible

Assessment Instruments are not perfect
